

This presentation will give a regulatory update on CBD regulation in Spain, France, and the UK and suggest possible regulatory harmonization of CBD at an EU-level. With the development of research and a wider acceptance of cannabis-related products, Europe's market is flourishing. But, while CBD-derived products can now be found easily in several EU countries, some hemp-extracts including CBD still inhabits a grey area. European regulation does not control CBD by any means, so all member states have different laws concerning growing, producing, selling, or importing products with CBD and/or THC. One of the key risks for new market entrants is the changing regulatory landscape. The presentation contributes to the understanding of the nuances of regulation in the Spanish, French, and UK markets in order to help attendants to assess how their products may be affected.
